Intolerance of risk and nuisances leads to national standards of taste and public accountability rather than privacy

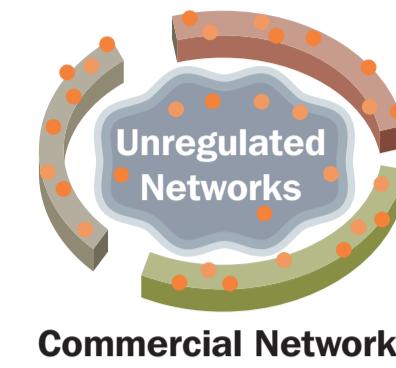


Access: Limited to a publicly-funded service for children and young teens, or push to talk with people they know

Paying to Play on the Multinet

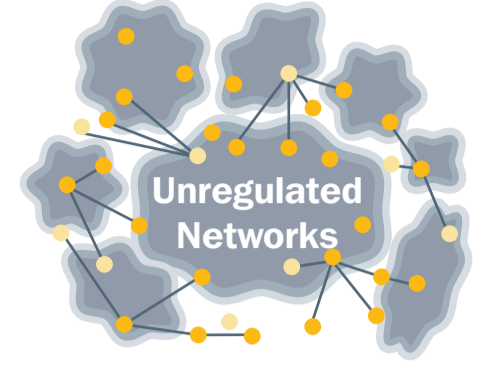
The market delivers entertainment-led walled gardens and standards are enforced through parents' consumer choices
